SUBJECT PRONOUNS

In many ways, Spanish is more **gender-specific** than English. When we look at the subject pronouns the following is noticed.

Let's look at the word "nosotros." This means "we" in the sense of a group containing at least one male. If the group contains only females, the word "nosotras" is used.

So, in Spanish, there are two ways to say "we":



**nosotros**  
we (masculine or mixed group)



**nosotras**  
we (feminine)

This same idea applies to the English word "they":

**ellos**  
they (masculine or mixed group)

**ellas**  
they (feminine)

**Hasta  
pronto**
