UK LORD CALLS ON TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO'S TRADE AND INDUSTRY MINISTER

February 19, 2016:- Senator the Honourable Paula Gopee-Scoon, Minister of Trade and Industry received a call from a visiting British delegation, led by the Honourable Lord Michael Howard, Member of the House of Lords in the United Kingdom and executives of the British Caribbean Chamber of Commerce (BCCC) on Thursday 18th February, 2016.
