<u>02 May, 2021:</u> The Ministry of Trade and Industry notes the responses of various segments of the business community in light of the announcement made by the Government on Thursday 29 April, 2021. Members of the business community are reminded that the additional sacrifice being requested at this time is meant to preserve the health and safety of their customer base, employees and by extension citizens of Trinidad and Tobago. Accordingly, if our national efforts are successful, it will allow the country's economy to emerge stronger.
