## Executive Summary


The Goods Declaration Module saw a **3.3% decrease in activity** for the month of **June 2025** when compared to the previous month, with the total volume of entries submitted to TTBizLink going from **10,524 to 10,176** declarations. Furthermore, there was an **6.2% decrease** in the number of declarations submitted to TTBizLink when compared to **June 2024** – with 10,847 Customs Entries routed to TTBizLink during that month. The average processing time among OGAs in **June 2025** was **35.75 hours**. This is above the average processing time for the previous month which was 20.83 hours.

Upon further analysis, this increase in processing time is associated with the higher than average processing time of Plant Quarantine Services (PQS), which was 96.02 hours for the month whereas their average processing time for the previous year was 23.03 hours. PQS stated that this was due to being severely understaff with key officers being on leave and therefore, there was a limitation on the human resources required to allow for efficient processing..

## TT\$ Value of Declarations Routed to Each Agency

A total of **TT\$4.5 Bn** worth of goods entered Trinidad and Tobago in June 2025. The below table and chart gives further information on selectivity by value<sup>1</sup>.


### Table and Chart Demonstrating OGA Selectivity by Value


