## Executive Summary


The Goods Declaration Module saw a **15.3% decrease in activity** for the month of **November 2025** when compared to the previous month, with the total volume of entries submitted to TTBizLink going from **12,226 to 10,360** declarations. Furthermore, there was an **18.4% decrease** in the number of declarations submitted to TTBizLink when compared to **November 2024** – with 12,701 Customs Entries routed to TTBizLink during that month. The average processing time among OGAs in **November 2025** was **13.99 hours**. This is below the average processing time for the previous month which was 16.39 hours.

According to feedback from some of the Brokerage Community, the observed decrease in activity may have been associated with uncertainty that arose from the situation between the United States of America and Venezuela for this month. This uncertainty appears to have coincided with more cautious importation behavior, with some importers reportedly reducing import activities during this period.

## TT\$ Value of Declarations Routed to Each Agency

A total of **TT\$5.4 Bn** worth of goods entered Trinidad and Tobago in November 2025. The below table and chart gives further information on selectivity by value<sup>1</sup>.


### Table and Chart Demonstrating OGA Selectivity by Value


